

Holocaust replica suitcases

Museum quality aluminum replica suitcases displaying images and stories of the Holocaust. The suitcases ask the viewer a series of open questions to consider the impact of hate while encouraging them to stand-up against racism. The following images in this document are of the displays placed on tables in a school library. Some cases have a display area where books can be placed to provide more context.
